## Use of the Certified Forester® Trademark

The term “Certified Forester® and the Certified Forester® trademark (registered with the US Patent and Trade Office), pictured left, are trademarks of the Society of American Foresters’ Certified Forester program.

SAF grants a non-exclusive and non-transferable license to use the “Certified Forester” term and/or trademark, above, as long as the CF remains in compliance with all Certified Forester requirements and procedures. Unless terminated, this license may be renewed upon approval by SAF of recertification.

Certification is an individual and personal credential. Certification trademark use or implied status cannot be transferred to another individual. This license permits the certified forester only to designate his/her Certified Forester status. A CF’s business, firm or agency is not certified. Use of the term “Certified Forester”, and/or the CF trademark, must be in conjunction with the CF’s name, as on a business card or accompanying a signature on correspondence, and not on company, agency, or business advertisements or promotions where the certificant’s name is absent.

A CF agrees to immediately cease any use of the “Certified Forester” term and/or trademark in reference to his/her past certified status upon notice from SAF that certification has been revoked, suspended, or expired.

A Candidate Certified Forester **MAY NOT** utilize the term “Certified Forester®” or the Certified Forester® trademark.

SAF grants a non-exclusive and non-transferable use of the term “Candidate Certified Forester™”, pictured right, as long as the CCF remains in compliance with all requirements and procedures within the Certified Forester program. Unless terminated, this license may be renewed upon approval by SAF.

# Candidate Certified Forester

The “Candidate Certified Forester™” credential is an individual and personal credential. The term use or implied status cannot be transferred to another individual. This license permits the candidate certified forester only to designate his/her Candidate Certified Forester status. A CCF’s business, firm, or agency is not certified. Use of the term “Candidate Certified Forester”, and/or CCF, must be in conjunction with the CCF’s name, as on a business card or accompanying a signature on correspondence, and not on company, agency, or business advertisements or promotions where the Candidate Certified Forester’s name is absent.

A Candidate Certified Forester agrees to immediately cease any use of the “Candidate Certified Forester” term reference to his/her past credential status upon notice from SAF that the credential has been revoked, suspended, or expired.
